Use of strollers or baby joggers and headsets or walkmans/iPods, are not permitted on the course during the 5K Run.

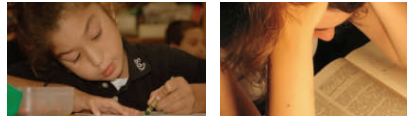
